

Summer 2022 COVID-19 Policies

- **Are masks required indoors at Brushstrokes?**

Yes, for now. We are paying close attention to local, state and federal guidelines for protecting ourselves and our community. As COVID-19 infection rates and guidelines change, we may amend our masking policy.

- **When should we stay home and cancel Brushstrokes parties and events?**

Anyone experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19 should stay home until symptoms have subsided and they have received a negative test (on or after day 5 from the onset of symptoms). Anyone who is unvaccinated or partially vaccinated AND who has had an exposure to COVID-19 should stay home until they have received a negative COVID-19 test on or after day 5 from the date of exposure. Day of exposure is day 0.

- **My child has had a COVID-19 exposure, can they still attend camp?**

- First, if your child has been in camp since their exposure, please notify Brushstrokes right away by calling Jessica at (510)637-8955
- If your child is fully vaccinated, and is entirely symptom-free, they may continue to attend camp, and should be tested on day 5 (day 0 is the day of exposure)
- If your child is unvaccinated or partially vaccinated, they should stay home and be tested on day 5 (day 0 is the day of exposure). If a PCR test done on day 5 comes back negative, they may begin or return to their camp session camp.

- **Can I get a refund if I need to cancel a party?**

We can not issue a refund for a canceled party. But you can apply your party deposit to a future date.

- **Can I get a refund or credit if my child is unable to attend part or all of their camp session?**

We are not able to issue a refund or credit for missed camp days or sessions. But, we will put together a take home activity kit for your child to do a project at home.
